WHAT HAPPENS IN YEAR 2?

- Weekly assemblies
- Daily English and Mathematics sessions
- Regular Handwriting and Phonics/SPAG sessions
- Weekly Music, Arts, Science and Humanities lessons
- 2 P.E sessions weekly. Each class has their set days....

Acer- Monday and Thursday

Beech –Wednesday and Friday

Cedar –Tuesday and Friday

Sycamore – Monday and Thursday

P.E Kit

- Black shorts, leggings or tracksuit bottoms
- T-shirt in the colour of your child's house team (Ochre - yellow; Emerald - green; Indigo - purple; Alizarin - red)
- Jumper for when doing PE outside (children may use their school jumper as long as it is on top of their PE t-shirt)
- Black pumps or trainers (no bright laces)



THE DAILY ROUTINE ...

- Morning Welcome – children have a ‘soft start’ from 8:40.
Official register is at 08:50am and all children must be there at this time.
- Afternoon Dismissal – Children to be dismissed by the class teacher at 3.20 from the playground and only when the whole class are ready and their adult is present.
- Playtime – children have one morning playtime and a longer lunchtime play for an hour.



READING...

- Every Friday, your child will be sent home with a levelled reading book.
- Parent/Carers must comment and sign the '*Reading Record*' to ensure your child's book can be changed.
- Please ensure books are returned by Wednesday at the latest to ensure a new book can be sent home on Friday.
- If any books go missing or are damaged, you will be charged.
- Reading is so incredibly important, please aim for your child to read 4-5 times a week.

PHONICS AND SPAG...

- Phonics is a way of teaching children how to read and write. It helps children hear, identify and use different sounds within words.
- Some children will re-sit the '*Year 1 statutory Phonics Screening Check*' in the Summer half term and will also attend a Phonics intervention.
- All children will attend a 20 minute Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar lesson in class 3 times a week.

PICK UP AND DROP OFF...

- **Ensure parking is appropriate, avoiding zigzags and double parking.**
- **Ensure your child is dropped off at the gate and not walking on their own.**



UNIFORM ACCESSORIES...

- Black, blue, white or grey socks or tights.
- Head coverings (hijab), bands, weaves or bobbles for the hair should be plain black, blue, orange, grey or white.
- No jewellery, other than plain studs for pierced ears.
- Children should not wear nail varnish to school.
- Children from the Sikh community are allowed to wear a Kara.
- Children are allowed to wear analogue/digital watches but no smart watches.
