What is the capital city?

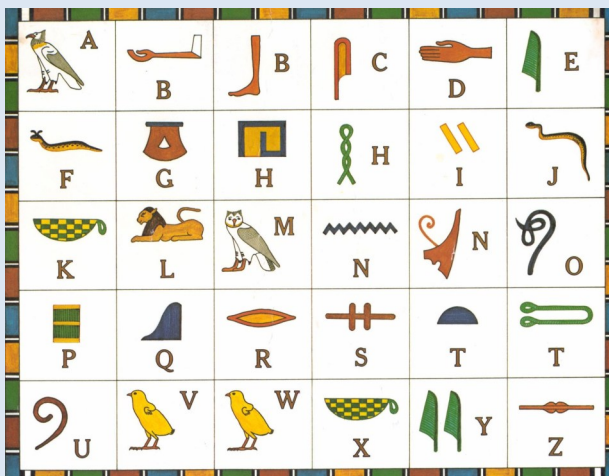
Can you label the main cities in Egypt?

**2 POINT TASK**

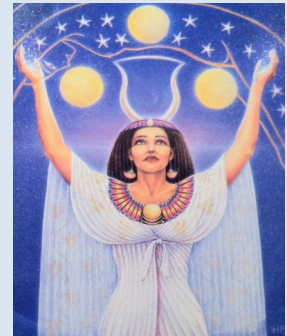


Can you write your name using hieroglyphics?

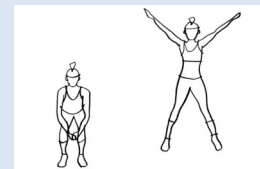
Design a name card and bring in to school to add to the topic table.

The Egyptian god Nut was the goddess of the sky. She was depicted as being covered in stars like a night sky. How many star jumps can you do in 1 minute?

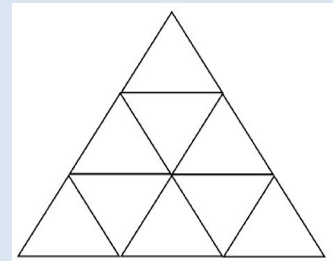


Try this over 7 days to see if you can improve your count!

### 3 POINT TASK

Do you want to learn more about what Ancient Egyptians loved to eat?

Create a food diary and try a different healthy Ancient Egyptian snack every week and tell us if you enjoyed it!

Write a story set in Ancient Egypt. It could feature the Egyptian Gods, Goddesses, pharaohs, priests and a range of other characters found in Egypt.

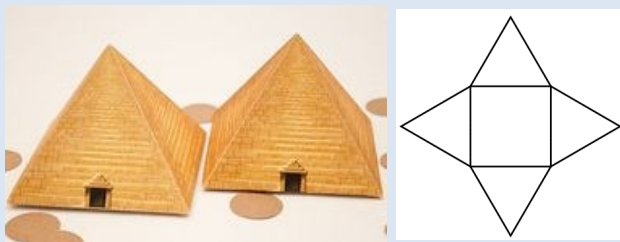


Can you include dialogue using inverted commas?
