1 POINT TASK

Choose either 2,3,5,6 or 10, roll a dice and using those 2 numbers complete a fact family.

Challenge yourself to complete an addition and subtraction fact family and a multiplication and division fact family.

Fact Family

Multiplication Division

$4 \times 5 = 20$
 $5 \times 4 = 20$
 $20 \div 4 = 5$
 $20 \div 5 = 4$

2 POINT TASK– show not tell!

Can you create your own show not tell paragraph?

Write a short 'show not tell' paragraph for an emotion of your choice. Remember...you cannot tell the reader what your emotion is. You can only show them by describing what the physical and emotional response is to that feeling.

Showing Not Telling Emotions & Feelings

<p>AFRAID</p> <p>hands shaking knees like jelly covered mouth with hand heavy, fast breathing heart pounding whimpering</p>	<p>NERVOUS</p> <p>tapping hands or feet biting bottom lip/nails butterflies in stomach stuttering lump in your throat playing with hair</p>	<p>EMBARRASED</p> <p>blushing/turn red hanging head low holding back tears rolling eyes stomach flips hiding face</p>
<p>ANGRY</p> <p>red in the face hands on hips jaw/fists clenched veins popping dark squinted eyes punching hand into fist</p>	<p>HOT</p> <p>bright red face sweat on face/back fanning self with hand moving slowly panting for breath drenched hairline</p>	<p>HAPPY</p> <p>smiling face eyes wide open corners of mouth rising jumping up and down laughing giggling on 'cloud nine'</p>

Can you find and research a parable whose message you think is important? Write the parable in your own words and explain the meaning and message of the parable.



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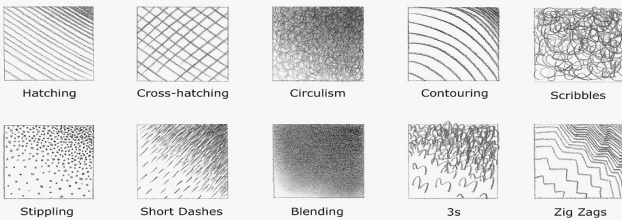
5 POINT TASK

Can you sketch and shade your own Iron Man face?



Using the shading techniques below, create your own 3D Iron Man drawing. You could use black card and chalk to create different effects or simply a pencil.

Challenge: Can you draw and shade any other parts of Iron Man's body? What is the difference between an H and B pencil?



5 POINT TASK

Collect your own recyclable materials to create your own Iron Man junk models.



Challenge: Iron Man was 20 feet tall. Can you create a scaled down version? A 2 foot model would be 1/10 the original size. Can you show how you scaled down your Iron Man model using maths?

5 POINT TASK

Create some fun magnetic art with this activity!

All you need is paper, paint, a magnet and a magnetic object. Place your magnet under the paper and your magnetic item on top and watch the paint move around the paper.



3 POINT TASK- Dreams and goals
