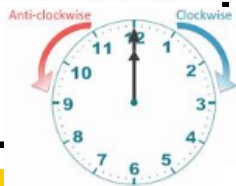

Five Point Activities

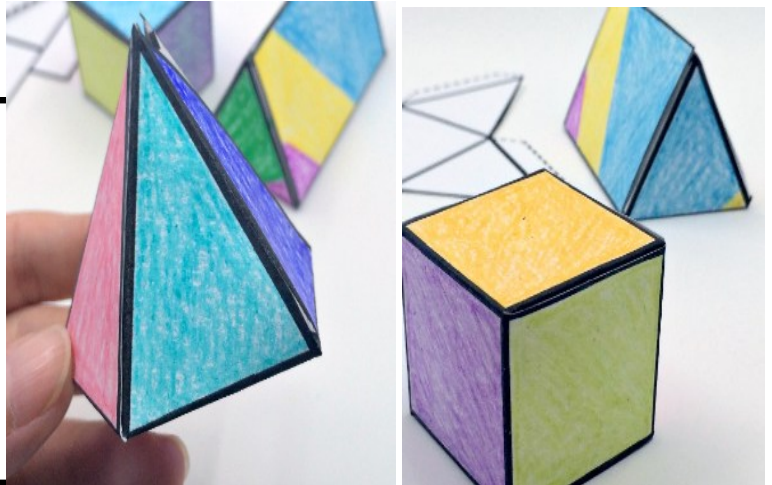
3D shapes!
