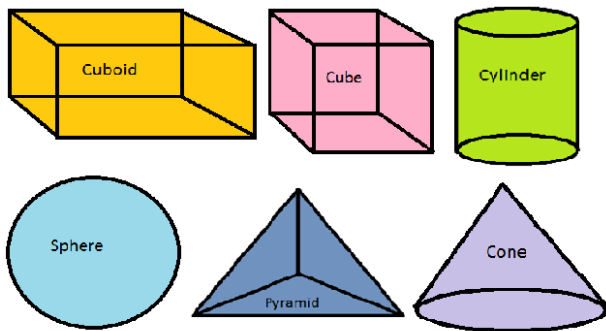
Shape

Challenge-

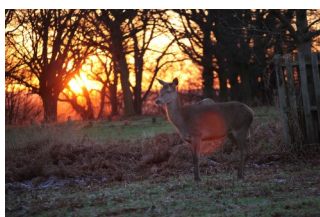
On each object, can you identify the number of:

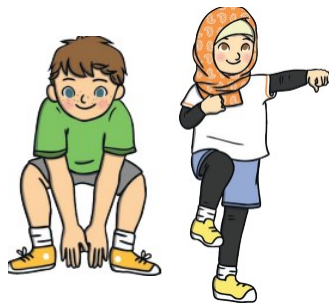
Aerobics

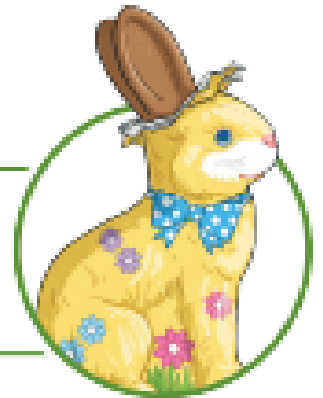
