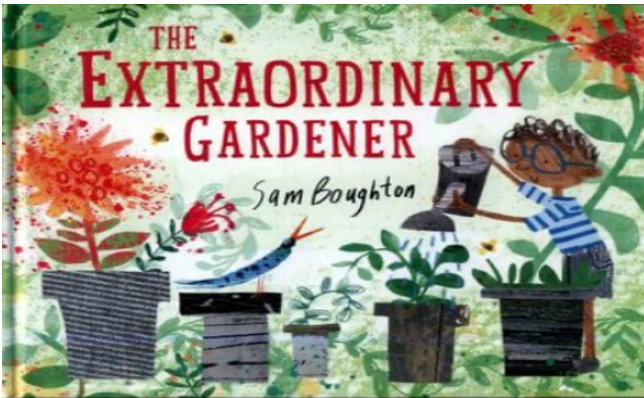

Three Point Activities

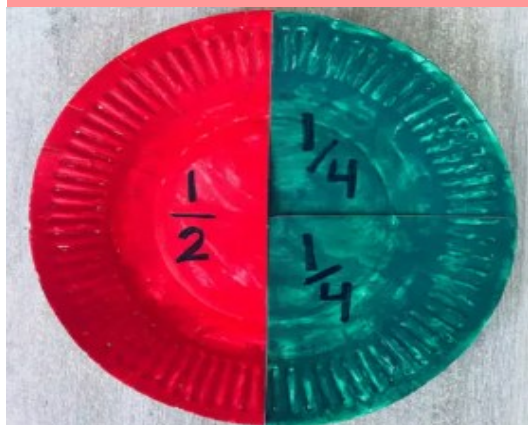
Art Skills
