

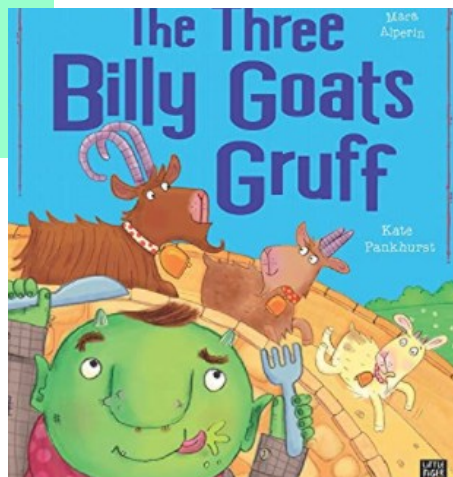

This term our topic book is **The Three Billy Goats Gruff**.

Within this pack is a range of homework activities linked to our topic 'Traditions & Family' to complete alongside reading.



Questions to ask your child:

What did the troll say when he could hear the goats coming over the bridge?

Why do you think the troll didn't want the goats to cross the bridge?

How would you feel if someone did something that you didn't want them to do?

The children will be able to choose from different activities with the aim of collecting up to 10 points. Listed inside this booklet are some of the tasks that are worth one point, two points, three points or five points. You and your child can choose which activities you would like to complete but remember you only need to collect 10 points. However, you are very welcome to complete as many as you want.

One Point Activities

Traditional Tales

How many different traditional tales can you name? Who are your favourite characters and why? Draw a picture of your favourite character and write sentences about them using adjectives.



Healthy Me

In PD, we will be learning how to keep our bodies safe and healthy.

- Can you keep an exercise diary everyday for a week?
- How can we keep ourselves safe when crossing the road?
- Why is it important we brush our teeth?

Animals and Humans

This term in Science, we will be learning how to group animals according to what they eat. How many carnivores can you name? What are herbivores? Can you make a list of omnivores? Draw or make a list of some animals that are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores and the things they eat.



Two Point Activities

Sikhism

In RE this half term we will be focusing on Sikhism and learning about the beliefs and practices of Sikh families. Can you make a mind map detailing all the information you know about the Sikh religion? You can use pictures and symbols.

Tricky Worded Problems

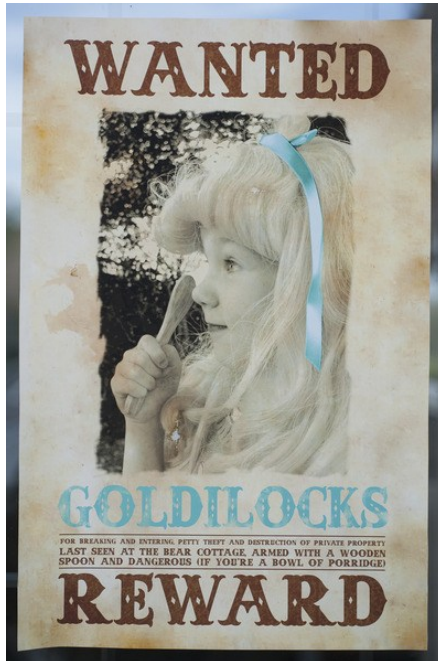
We have been learning how to solve one step multiplication and division problems. Can you read the worded problems and decide what you need to do to solve it. Record your answers in a number sentence.

Three Point Activities

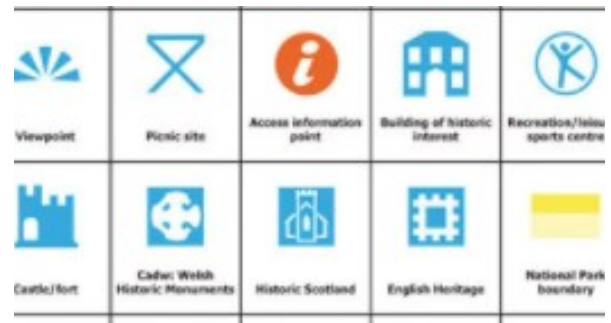
Wanted Posters

Map Symbols

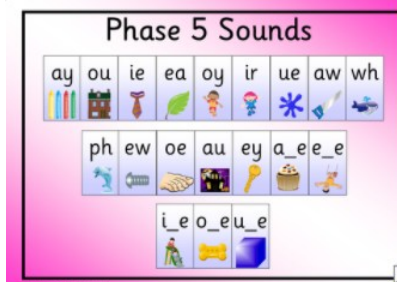
This term in Geography, we will be looking at the different features of a map. Can you draw and label how human and physical features are shown on a map? You could create a map showing the area around Bannockburn School.

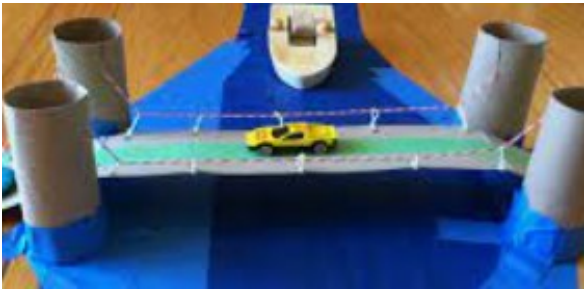
Look at different objects around your home. Can you see any objects that contain Phase 5 sounds? Write them down using your sounds. Can you write sentences using Phase 5 tricky words?
