

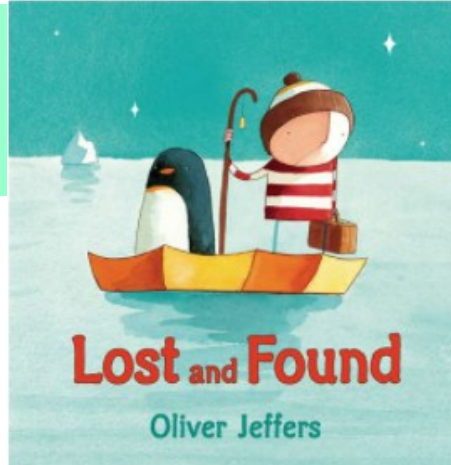

Within this pack is a range of homework activities linked to our topic 'Other Lands' to complete alongside daily reading.

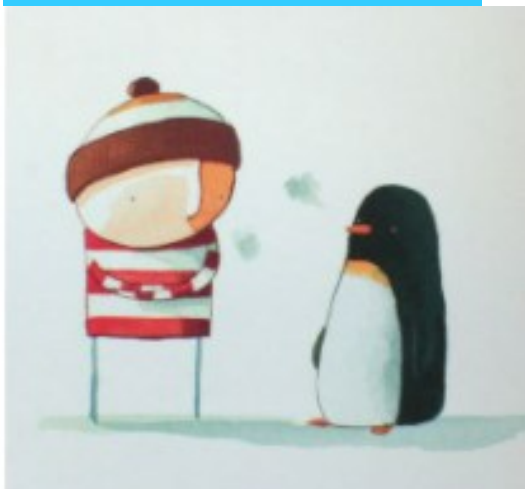


Questions to ask and research with your child:

What facts do you know about The Polar Regions?

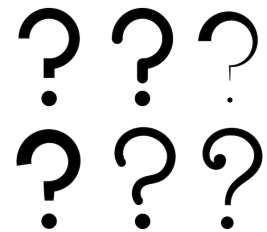
What do you know about wheeled vehicles?

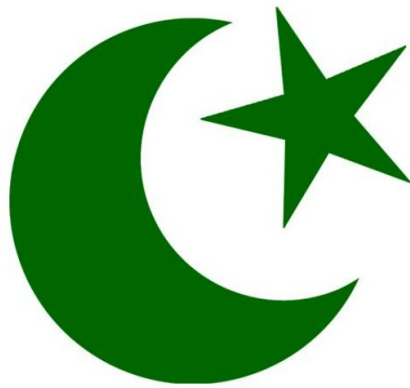

Two Point Activities

Islam

In RE this half term we will be focusing on Islam and learning about the beliefs and practices of Muslim families. Can you make a mind map detailing all the information you know about the Islamic religion? You can use pictures and symbols.



Polar Animals

Where are the north and south poles? What is it like there? What animals live there?

Maths Word Problems

In Maths, we will be practising our addition and subtraction with teen numbers. Can you read the problems and decide what you need to do to solve it. Record your answers in a number sentence.

1. The penguin had 16 fish. She decided to give 11 away to Oliver. How many fish does the penguin have now?
2. Oliver saw 13 seals, 2 birds flying in the sky and 4 icebergs in the ocean. How many item did he find altogether?
3. Oliver and the penguin played a game of hide and seek that lasted 19 minutes. They then had a swimming race that lasted 11 minutes. How much longer did they play hide and seek?

Three Point Activities

Amazing animals!

This term in Science, we will be learning about animals, including humans.

Can you name any reptiles, mammals, amphibians, birds or fish?

Create a poster of your favourite animal and write sentences to describe it. Why is it your favourite animal? Have you ever seen one in real life?

Remember to include pictures and as many interesting facts as you can or take a trip to a zoo or farm as a family.



DT

In DT, we will be learning about animal transportation.

What has wheels and axle?

Can you draw a diagram of something with wheels and explain how the axles work?

Can you create your own toy with axles and wheels?

Practise your counting in jumps of 2s, 5s and 10s to find the missing numbers. Remember to look for the pattern to help you.
