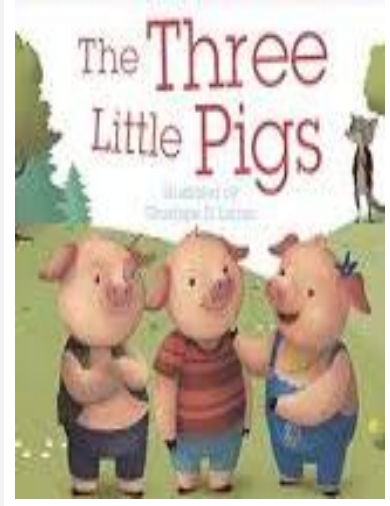

English

This term we will be reading 'The Three Little Pigs' by Giuseppe Di Lernia. We will be focusing on developing our vocabulary to describe what we can see, hear and feel through drama. To help us expand our vocabulary, we will create our own dens out of various materials to build a house. We will also familiarise ourselves with a quality model text to help us write a set of instructions based on our text.

You can help: By encouraging your child to practise learning to spell their tricky words that we sent home and using their phonics to write down new unfamiliar words.

Maths

In Maths we will be looking at the composition of numbers, how to break numbers apart and put them together as a group. We will be looking at differences in weight, length and capacity, as well as comparing units of time.

You can help: Encourage your child to become familiar with numbers in different activities, children should add two parts to find the sum and subtract to find the unknown part.

Science

In Science, we will be researching different types of every day materials we might find in our local environment. We will be using adjectives to describe what they feel like and what they can be used for. We will be exploring the important properties of everyday materials such as their shape, texture, colour and flexibility.

You can help: By talking with your child about the different types of materials which are used to make things in your home. For example: what materials are sofas, cars and clothes made from?

Geography

This term we will be learning about the local area. We will explore maps, atlases and look at the UK and its four countries: England, Scotland, Wales, and Northern Ireland.

R.E.

This term children will be looking at Christianity. They will learn about who Jesus is and look at different stories from the Bible, including the Christmas story.

Art

This term we will experiment with a range of media to learn about formal elements of art including the use of line, composition and colour. Children will find out about artists and use their work as inspiration to create their own art.

P.E.

In P.E. we will be developing our locomotor skills, gross motor skills as well as fine motor skills. We will learn continue to develop teamwork skills by taking part in team challenges and using apparatus.
