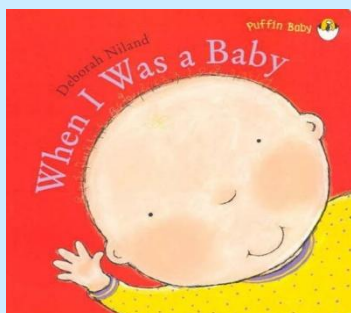
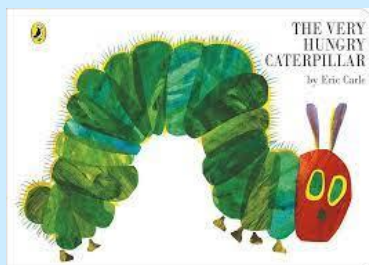
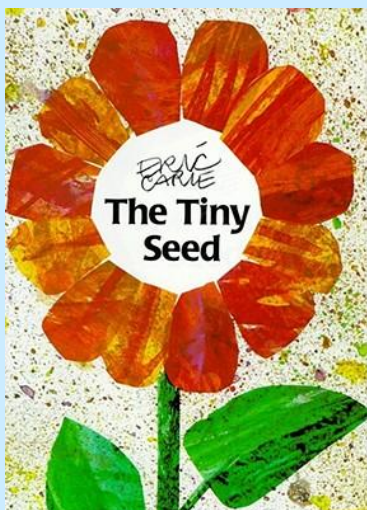

Areas of Learning

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

What we will do: Learn about how to look after ourselves by exploring a healthy diet, exercise and lifestyle. Learn about keeping ourselves clean and brushing our teeth.

You could support by: offering your child a range of food and telling them what each type of food is good for. Laying out your child's clothes and encouraging them to get themselves dressed.

Physical Development

What we will do: learn about how to keep our bodies healthy by exercising and discussing why it is important to exercise. We will learn movements to strengthen certain areas the human body.

You could support by: doing some exercise together such as walking, skipping or jogging and discussing the impact of exercise on our bodies.

Communication and Language

What we will do: Talk about how we have changed since we were babies and how we have changed. Talk about how we will grow in the future.

You could support by: sharing baby pictures at home of different family members and encourage your child to talk about what they can see and how people grow and change.

Maths

What we will do: Learn the days of the week and count to 5 linked to reading 'The Very Hungry Caterpillar' story. We will also sing songs to learn the days of the week.

You could support by: Singing the days of the week together. Telling your child what the day is each morning and asking them what the day was yesterday and what the day will be tomorrow.

Literacy:

What we will do: Share stories about growing and changes in plants and animals. Continue to learn songs to strengthen memory. We will mark make and use playdough to help strengthen the muscles in our hands.

You could support by: asking your child which songs they have been singing at Nursery and singing along with them.

Creative Arts and Design

What we will do: Create pieces of Art related to spring time and give children opportunities to make caterpillars and butterflies in different ways.

You could support by: giving your child equipment to make their own Spring pictures.

Understanding the World

What we will do: Explore the season of Spring and how plants and animals change within this season. Observe a caterpillar turning into a butterfly.

You could support by: discussing the changes you notice to plants and trees outside.
